
In this interactive presentation, my goal is to **inspire the next generation of Jewish authors** to write and publish their stories. First, I will share my journey to become a children's author and the role Judaism plays in my creative life. We will address why it's important for Jewish children to see themselves reflected positively in contemporary literature. Then I will share with you my process to turn an idea into a real book. Where do my ideas come from? How do I revise my stories? Who illustrates the book... and MORE!

What does a typical school visit look like?



During an in-person visit, I usually give two engaging presentations:

- Grades 1-2 (30 minutes)
- Grades 3-5 (45 minutes)

I also spend time connecting with a smaller group during the day-- such as a specific creative writing club etc... whatever suits your school best. Every visit includes time to sign and personalize books for students.

What is the best way to get ready for my visit?

To make the most of our time together, I recommend introducing my books to your students ahead of the visit and encouraging them to come up with thoughtful questions—about my stories, the writing process, or what life as an author is really like. The more curious and creative, the better! I'll need a projector and screen for visuals and a microphone for larger groups.

Book Signing & Ordering

I do not bring books to sell at my events. However, students often enjoy having a copy for me to sign after my presentations. Partnering with a local bookstore is a wonderful option, and books can also be ordered directly from the publisher. Of course, ordering books is not a requitement!


